

WHEN MAY I APPLY TO THE CONCURRENT PROGRAM?

Apply at any time during the academic year! DU concurrent courses start in the spring semester with the final courses offered during Davenport's fall/winter semesters.

WHAT IS THE DAVENPORT UNIVERSITY ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR THE CONCURRENT PROGRAM?

Students must be admitted to Montcalm CC ADN program with a minimum GPA of 3.0. While in the program students are required to maintain a 3.0 GPA in DU courses.

WHAT IS THE CONCURRENT APPLICATION PROCESS?

- 1. Apply to Davenport University at davenport.edu/apply
- 2. Send official transcripts from Montcalm CC and any other colleges universities you attended to DU Registrar electronictranscripts@davenport.edu
- 3. Apply to the concurrent nursing program, using the concurrent paper application from <u>davenport.edu/completion</u> or obtain one from your advisor, admissions rep or nursing coordinator.

HOW WILL I WILL BE NOTIFIED IF I AM ACCEPTED?

The DU Registrar will notify you by an emailed letter of acceptance or denial from the nursing department.

ARE THERE OTHER STEPS I MUST COMPLETE BEFORE STARTING THE CONCURRENT PROGRAM AT DAVENPORT?

Once admitted to the concurrent program, you will meet with your advisor and financial aid counselor. During this process you will discuss your course schedule financial aid options and payment process.

WHERE ARE CONCURRENT CLASSES TAUGHT?

Concurrent courses are held on campus at Montcalm CC. Students will also have the option to take DU courses in a in seat/online format once they have completed the ADN program at Montcalm CC.

WHO ARE THE FACULTY?

DU Faculty are required to have a minimum of a Master's degree, which may include faculty from the ADN program at Montcalm CC.

IS THERE CONCURRENT ACADEMIC ADVISING AND PRACTICUM COORDINATION AVAILABLE?

Students admitted in the concurrent program will have an academic advisor and will also begin coordinating practicum experiences with the Nursing Coordinator/Associate Department Chair their first semester.

ARE SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID AVAILABLE TO THE CONCURRENT STUDENTS?

Students will receive a special concurrent rate in this program. A financial aid consortium is set up between Montcalm CC and DU for students to use federal financial aid at both institutions. Include Davenport University on your FAFSA to be eligible: DU code 002249
