## Housing

- If you are homeless or need housing assistance the Housing and Homeless Hotline is a great place to start. EightCAP provides both housing and homeless assistance to those in need along with a variety referral and resource opportunities.
- Examples of the types of services offered by the Housing & Homeless sector include, but not limited to:
  - Emergency Shelter through Hotel/Motel Vouchers
  - Housing Choice Voucher Sign-up (with Homeless Preference)
  - Rent Arrear Payment (court ordered evictions)
  - Security Deposit Assistance
  - Rental Assistance (short- & mid-term)
  - Housing Assistance specific to Veterans (click for SSVF flier)
  - State ID & Birth Certificate Assistance related to housing
