RN-BSN or ADN-BSN Program

- 1. Apply to SVSU using the following link, <u>SVSU Undergraduate and Graduate Application</u>. There are no application fees.
- 2. If you completed courses at a previous university under a birth/other last name, please be sure to list that in your application. SVSU requires an official transcript from EACH institution previously attended.
- 3. When you apply, please specify the type of student that summarizes your Individual circumstance:
 - A. Transfer student: For students who are transferring from another institution and have not completed courses at SVSU previously or earned a Bachelor's Degree.
 - B. Second Bachelor's Degree Student: For students who have already completed a Bachelor's Degree.
 - C. Readmit Student: For students who have previously completed courses at SVSU.
- 4. When applying to SVSU please select the correct major that fits your individual circumstance:
 - A. ADN to BSN, Concurrent Program: Select *Nursing ADN to B.S.N*. This is for any ADN concurrent student who is intending to be simultaneously enrolled in ADN clinical courses at another institution while taking SVSU courses.
 - B. RN to BSN Program: Select *Nursing RN to B.S.N.* This is for the active practicing RN, who has completed their ADN and is a licensed Registered Nurse in the State of Michigan.
- 5. Once you apply, you must send all of your official transcripts to SVSU. SVSU recommends using the National Student Clearinghouse site to send official transcripts. An unofficial copy of all your transcripts should be sent to the RN to BSN Coordinator, rnbsn@svsu.edu.
- 6. Transcripts will be officially evaluated by the Registrar and an individualized program plan will be developed for you. This plan will be reviewed with you at your virtual orientation with the RN to BSN Coordinator.
- 7. You do not have to participate in a traditional orientation session on campus. You will have a virtual 'orientation' with the RN to BSN coordinator (<u>Click Here to Schedule</u>) to discuss your individualized academic plan and what to expect while in the program.
