1.	Michigan produces a lot of these trees – we are one of the top 3 producers of this tree. Can you guess what holiday is probably responsible for its use?

2.	Michigan has a lot of these trees. There are red, white, black, pin, just to name a few. What type of nut does this tree produce?
	(The average tree produces about 10 million of these in its lifetime!)

3.	What do you see below/on the ground near this birdhouse? Hint: It is often thought these are only found in the desert!
4.	This water often is only here 3 seasons of the year. What is a body of water that is only present part of the year, particularly in the spring, called?
5.	This type of conifer grows quickly with relatively soft needles. The wood from this tree is used for furniture, flooring, and even paneling. It was always the favorite tree of loggers, since the logs could be processed through a lumber mill within a year of being cut down.

Sadly, the smooth bark of the trees often makes them a favorite for lovers' initials and other graffiti–even today despite knowing that such actions can be bad to the tree. 7.	These deciduous trees are renowned for their distinctive bark, which often features striking colors and unique textures. The bark of these trees can range from snowy white to silvery gray, and some species exhibit peeling or curling bark that adds to their appeal.
